Know 1-10, 12,13,14,15,16,18,19,21,22,25,26 Amendments

Know how many Amendments there are (27)

The First 10 are called Bill of Rights

The Five freedoms are in the 1st Amendment

1- Guarantees the Right to free Religion, speech, press, Assembly and petition

2- Right to Bear Arms (Here's my gun freeze) *hint- 2 arms*

3- Prohibits Quartering of troops in peace time (Soldiers get out please) *hint- 3's a crowd*

4- Prohibits Unreasonable search and seizer (Where's your warrant please?) *hint-search 4 something*

5- Rights of the Accused (Don't Rat on yourself) *hint- plead the 5th*

6- Right to a speedy trial (Right to a quick trial) *hint-S for Speedy*

7- Guarantees Jury trial in civil Lawsuits (Jury trial in civil cases) *hint-seven civil*

8- Prohibits cruel and Unusual Punishment (Don't lock me in dark places) *hint-8 looks like handcuffs*

9- Identifies powers reserved to the people (Powers of the people)

People before State! 9 before 10) *hint-9 is a backwards P for POWER of People*

10-Identifies powers reserved to the state (States have rights too)

12- Separate the ballots for President and Vice President

hint-1 president 2 vice is 12

To remember the three on civil rights remember they start at teenage years 13,14,15. First we FREED them, then we made them Citizens, finally they could vote!

13-Abolished slavery (slavery is invalid) *hint- 13 is unlucky unless you are a slave!*

14- Gave minorities' citizenship (Equal rights 4 all)

15- Gave African American Males the right to vote (All races get the ballot)

16-Congress can collect taxes from the people's income *hint-16 you get a job and pay taxes \$*

18-Establishes Prohibition (Alcohol will kill you)

Establish NO Drinking at age 18

19- Gave women the right to vote (Women vote like men do)

21- Repealed Prohibition (We can drink now wow!) --remember 21 to drink=21st amendment

Repeal the rule,,, we ALLOW Drinking at age 21

22- No more than 2 presidential terms (only two terms now)

Remember 2 and 2 for 2 terms

25- Defines Presidential succession (if Bill dies we've got Al)

26- Voting age is 18 (If we can die we can vote)

Remember 2+6= 8 and 8 is for 18 to vote!
